Stanton L. Wolkoff, 90, of Minneapolis, died on October 13, 2020, surrounded by his children. Preceded in death by parents William and Claire Wolkoff, and sister Sue and brother-in-law David Meyers. He interned at several accounting firms before joining his father's firm "Wolkoff, Effress & Co." as a CPA. He continued in the firm as it grew and merged, and retired as a partner at Price Waterhouse Coopers.

Some favorite memories of Stan include: spending time on his houseboat "The Office," ("I'll be at "the office" this afternoon.") cruising on the Mississippi and St. Croix rivers; visits in the winter to San Diego, eating at his favorite restaurants; getting cassette tapes of his favorite local radio shows in the mail; eating a late breakfast at "Manning's."

Stan was a warm, welcoming person. He easily made friends throughout his life.
